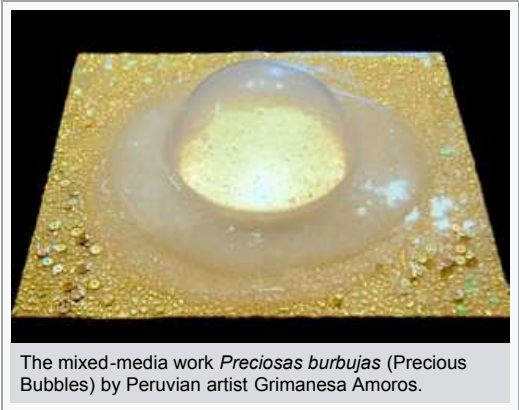

## Latin American fair arteaméricas smaller this year



The Latin American art fair arteaméricas 2009, which opens Friday and runs through Monday, is smaller this year -- only about 50 galleries from around the Americas are selling art work. But the fair is far richer in content with art conferences, sculpture and video art project rooms, curated art pavilions from Mexico, Argentina and Cuba, and a site-specific work created by Miami's José Bedia, a commission from the Miami Art Museum.
